

Chairman of Constitutional Court of the Czech Republic dr. Pavel Rychetský delivered to Professor Michal Tomášek, Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Law of Charles University in Prague and Head of Editorial board of the Lawyer Quarterly and to Professor Pavel Šturma, Member of the Board Antonín Randa Silver Medals awarded to them by Union of Czech Lawyers. Ceremony hold on 25th October 2019 in representative premises of the Patriotic Hall in Charles University Karolinum palace. Antonín Knight Randa (1834–1914) was Professor of civil law at Charles-Ferdinand Czech University in Prague, founder of modern Czech civil law, doctor honoris causa at universities in Bologna and Krakow. In 1883–1884 he was Rector of Charles-Ferdinand Czech University and in 1872 and 1875 Dean of its Faculty of Law. Union of Czech Lawyers was established in 1990 as a successor of Czech Lawyers Union established in 1864. Antonín Randa Medals (bronze, silver or gold) are granted annually to most prestigious Czech lawyers.
